HALLSDOWN ROAD, AYLESHAM

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

TEMPORARY ORDER 2018

To allow telecoms cabling works to be carried out in connection with the installation of broadband, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on Hallsdown Road, Aylesham, in the Dover area.

Phased closures are planned from Monday 12 February 2018, with estimated completion by 9 March 2018.

Hallsdown Road will be closed in sections, to the extent indicated by signage and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via Ratling Road, B2046 Adisham Road and Love Lane.

Due to the nature of the works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.

This Order comes into force from 12 February 2018 and remains in force until the works have been completed, with a maximum duration of 6 months.
